## RUDYARD TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE # 26 MODULAR AND MOBILE HOMES

## Amended May 6, 2003

- 1. All pre-owned modular houses and mobile homes moved into or within Rudyard Township shall be inspected as to exterior appearance and sound construction.
- 2. Mobile homes, modular houses and houses must be skirted within thirty (30) days after being moved to its new location in Rudyard Township, if it does not have a full masonry foundation.
- 3. An application for Zoning Compliance must be applied for before an inspection will be conducted.
- 4. The owner must state in writing his or her intent to bring the building up to Rudyard Township requirements within thirty (30) days, weather permitting. A time extension may be applied for if necessary.
- 5. Two inspectors will be appointed by the Rudyard Township Board with a two-year term. If they do not agree on an evaluation, the Township Supervisor will inspect and be the deciding vote on the matter.
- 6. A fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid to Rudyard Township before an inspection will be done.
- 7. Pictures will not be accepted, unless the home is more than fifty (50) miles away. Photographs must include all four (4) sides, the roof, windows, skirting, entryway and chimney.
- 8. Mobile homes within the residential district must comply with the National Mobile Home Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974, providing that the home meets minimum plumbing, electrical, mechanical and fire code standards established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for mobile homes.
- 9. The building shall be comparable/compatible with the neighborhood where it will be located.
- 10. The penalties for violating this ordinance are the same as those in the Rudyard Township Civil Infractions Ordinance.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance, having been duly published in the Community Voice on April 24, 2002, shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication.
